Next week, the Senate will take up The Lilly Ledbetter Fair Pay Act, legislation that will restore the ability of American workers to seek fair compensation for pay discrimination.

Tomorrow, Friday, April 18, at 11 a.m., Eastern time, Lilly Ledbetter will join Sarah Standiford, Executive Director of the Maine Women's Lobby, to call on Senator Collins to support this bill, which is critically important for workers in Maine who may face pay discrimination.

A recent 5-4 Supreme Court ruling, *Ledbetter v. Goodyear Tire and Rubber Company*, makes it virtually impossible for employees who face pay discrimination based on sex, race, ethnicity, religion, disability, and age to take action against their employers. The House of Representatives acted quickly to correct the Court's ruling by passing the Fair Pay Restoration Act. The Senate will take up the bill next week.
